
Michigan Elections: New Rankings For GOP Gubernatorial Primary In Michigan



- Republican Candidates for Governor square off in tomorrow's primary election on August 2nd: Tudor Dixon, Ryan Kelley, Kevin Rinke, Garret Soldano, Ralph Rebandt
- Secretary of State Benson said they are expecting upwards of 2.5 million votes
- Recent polling shows more undecided voters than actual support for candidates, signaling a weaker GOP field, 38% of voters are undecided with the leading GOP candidate Dixon receiving 20% support among voters
- James Craig was the frontrunner early on but was removed from the ballot, forcing a write-in candidacy, the undecided voting block is his best chance
- Howerer, 62% of the 38% undecided voters said a Trump endorsement would sway their vote; Trump endorsed Tudor Dixon. Leaving little wiggle room from Craig acknowledging an uphill battle and "rigged" election against him
- Trump-Backed candidate, Tudor Dixon is the projected winner



As we see above in exhibit A, Recent polling is very close considering the margin of error and a staggering 38% of voters still undecided this close to election day. Trump's endorsement of Tudor Dixon, I predict will be enough to hand her victory as 62% of undecided voters say a Trump endorsement would sway their vote.

Predictions, Exhibit B



(Exhibit B, reflects TTA predictions + Assumes maximum voter turnout predicted by SOS. 2.5 Million votes 100% voter turnout*)

Tudor Dixon is the projected winner receiving 43.56% of the vote. Trump's endorsement added 23.56% to her overall approval and/or voting prospects among undecided voters, as a whole undecided voters make up an outstanding 950,000 votes according to projections. We see Ryan Kelley and James Craig also receiving a bump in support among remaining undecided voters. We have seen Trump-backed candidates win all across the country showing President Trump's influence and popularity is only growing. Tudor Dixon winning the GOP nomination for Governor of Michigan sets up a showdown between incumbent Democrat Governor Gretchen Whitmer this November. Lt. Governor spot will also be up for grabs, who will Tudor pick for her ticket? Candidates for AG and SOS, Matt Deperno and Kristina Karamo are also Trump-backed candidates running in the General election this November.

Predictions, Exhibit C

(Exhibit C, below is based on average voter turnout historically per SOS, 1,909,620 votes 76% voter turnout*)

We predict the following: Dixon 43.56%, Kelley 21.2%, Rinke 14.5%, Soldano 11.2%, Rebandt 4.9%, Craig 4.6%.

Winner: Tudor Dixon
